6:50pm- 6:55pm	 Principal's Report - Tom Andrew 16 CTMS students were accepted into honors band. The kids gave an incredible performance. We also had students accepted into honors choir this year. They kids were able to train with an expert at a 2 day event and perform later on the second day. On Friday, the 16th of February, the school held a vertical articulation day: they met with feeder elementary schools and discussed targets and standards.
